Tulsa Health Department	<p>WIC provides wholesome foods, nutrition education and healthcare and social service referrals for women who are pregnant, breastfeeding, or post-partum as well as infants and children up to the age of 5. The Caring Van provides free immunizations for children. The Child Guidance and Healthcare staff provide services designed to promote optimal development, behavior and interaction for families with children. They provide free developmental, hearing, vision, speech and social-emotional screenings for children. Child Guidance also provides weekly group sessions for children and families under stress including Circle of Security early intervention program for parents and children, Circle of Parenting (for Circle of Security graduates), and Incredible Years Parent Program for parents of children 0 to 8 years of age focused on strengthening positive and nurturing parenting skills in order to promote children's social and emotional competencies and reduce conduct problems and challenging behaviors in children, such as aggression, and increasing their social and self-control skills.</p>
